- 1. Pinot Grigio, Veritiere, Italy** £20.00
Fresh, crisp and appealing, with small bubbles, a subtle bouquet, an apple fruit character and a well balanced acidity. (12% abv)
- 2. Taittinger, Brut Reserve, France** £45.00
Crisp, citrus aromas with subtle toasty notes leading to an elegant, balanced palate with a lively, mousse texture and a crisp, flavourful finish.

White Wines

- 3. Sauvignon Blanc, De Gras, Chile** £3.75 £4.95 £14.50
Dry with herbaceous characters alongside gooseberry, lychee and lemon, which are encouraged by a crisp structure. (13% abv)
- 4. Fiano, Mandra Rossa, Italy** £3.75 £4.95 £14.50
Medium bodied and dry with balancing acidity keeping the tropical fruits clean and refreshing with a dry, textured finish. (13.5% abv)
- 5. Pinot Grigio Via Nova, Contri, Italy** £3.75 £4.95 £14.50
Lemony on the nose, with a delicious balance in the mouth, this Pinot Grigio is a very easy-to-drink dry white with medium alcohol and a gorgeous lingering finish. (12% abv)
- 6. Terret / Viognier Lérane** £3.75 £4.95 £14.50
Vin de Pays d'Oc, France
Round and juicy offering a delightful concentration of peach and pear fruit and some hints of tropical lychees, all bound up with a crisp, citrus acidity. (12.5% abv)
- 7. Chardonnay, Weighbridge** £14.95
Peter Lehmann, Australia
A nose of fresh, sun-ripened white peaches balanced by a crisp acidity with a long, lingering finish.
- 8. Sauvignon Blanc Moa Ridge** £18.95
Lawsons Dry Hills, New Zealand
Inviting scents of white-currant, gooseberry and freshly cut grass are the overture to a vivacious, herbaceous and vibrant palate.
- 9. Chenin Blanc, Stormy Cape, South Africa** £14.95
Good concentration of sub tropical fruit and well balanced with fresh, citrus acidity and a dry finish.
- 10. Château Nicot Blanc, Bordeaux, France** £16.50
Powerful, elegant nose of vanilla, fresh butter, lemon, toasted almonds and linden blossom. Finishing with impressions of exotic fruit and wild mint.
- 11. Petit Chablis, Olivier Tricon, France** £20.00
A bright, elegant Petit Chablis with traditional crisp minerality and refreshing citrus-like acidity. Beautifully balanced.
- 12. Marqués de Riscal Limousin Reserva, Spain** £22.00
The palate is dense with underlying fine lees, dried fruits and toasted nuances from the cask ageing process.



Rosé Wines

- 13. Rosé, Weighbridge** £3.75 £4.95 £14.50
Peter Lehmann, Australia
Deliciously crisp, with delightful flavours of freshly picked summer berries, and a superbly clean finish. (12% abv)

Red Wines

- 14. Merlot Organic, Soleus, Chile** £3.75 £4.95 £14.50
Medium bodied, finely structured and fruit driven, with blackberry and morello cherry flavours, wood spice and a hint of vanilla. (14% abv)
- 15. Shiraz, My Word Is My Bond** £3.75 £4.95 £14.50
Peter Lehmann, Australia
Superb depth of fruit with lashings of dark chocolate and fine chalky tannins on the finish. (14.5% abv)
- 16. Rioja Tempranillo** £3.75 £4.95 £14.50
Vina Cerrada, Spain
Rounded and soft in the mouth, with a well balanced, medium bodied palate amply stacked with crunchy red berry and hedgerow fruit. (12.5% abv)
- 17. Cabernet Sauvignon** £3.75 £4.95 £14.50
Man Vintners, South Africa
A bold and juicy red wine with red-berry fruit flavours and a touch of smoky oak spice and soft tannins. (14% abv)
- 18. Sangiovese Poggio della Quercia, Contri, Italy** £14.95
Fruity and easy to drink with good structure and a nice, rounded finish.
- 19. Pinot Noir Hawkes Bay** £18.95
Trinity Hill, New Zealand
Classic, varietal characteristics such as plums, blackcurrants and cherries are evident in this silky textured wine, entwined with earthy, smoky oak notes.
- 20. Côtes Du Rhône Rouge, Le Pas de la Beaume** £15.75
Cave de Cairanne, France
Medium bodied and supple with a generous amount of succulently textured ripe forest fruit. The structure is soft and the finish clean and moreish.
- 21. Douro Red, Quinta do Crasto, Portugal** £17.95
Rich and spicy with ripe tannins and a long, smooth, velvety finish.
- 22. Château des Gravières, Collection Prestige** £20.25
Bordeaux, France
Woody and toasty aromas of prunes and liquorice. Fleshy, robust and well-balanced with a firm, lengthy finish.
- 23. The Cabernets Skilloalee** £23.00
Clare Valley, Australia
Full and soft with sweet, leafy fruit flavours, rich vanillin oak and firm, drying tannins on a lingering finish.
